Sub: BIE, AP – Examinations – IPASE 2021 – Due Dates for Payment of the Examination fee for 1st & 2nd year Regular and ex-students (General and Vocational), Attendance exempted Private candidates for Humanities only (without college study) and candidates who wish to appear with change of group – Reg.

This is to notify that, the following are the prescribed due dates for payment of examination fee for **First & Second year** Regular students, ex-failed candidates (General and Vocational) and Attendance exempted private candidates (without college study) for Humanities groups and candidates with change of Group who wish to appear for the ensuing Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations 2021:

The due dates for the payment of Examination Fee for IPASE 2021 are prepared for approval. The following are the conditions for the payment of the Examination Fee:

- The Candidates of First Year Intermediate who had paid Examination Fee for IPE March 2021 need not pay any Examination Fee for appearing IPASE 2021.
- 2) The Candidates of Second Year Intermediate who had paid Examination Fee for IPE March 2021 and not satisfied with the result, can improve their marks by appearing the IPASE 2021 Examinations and need not pay the Examination Fee. The better of two results will be taken for issuance of certificate.
- 3) The Candidates of First Year & Second Year who have not registered for IPE March 2021, and not paid examination fee for IPE March 2021 has to pay the Examination fee for appearing IPASE 2021 Examinations.
- 4) Attendance Exemption candidates has to pay the Examination Fee.

The following are the rates and due dates for payment of examination fee for Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations 2021 which are scheduled to be held from 15-09-2021 to 23-09-2021.

The above due dates are applicable for both **General and Vocational students**, Attendance exempted private candidates for Humanities only (without college study) and candidates who wish to appear for the ensuing Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations 2021 with change of group.

ATTENDANCE EXEMPTED CANDIDATES:

The above due date is also applicable to private candidates (without college study) who were already granted exemption from attendance to appear (Humanities combination only) for Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations

2021. These candidates are directed to pay the examination fee to the Principals of the Govt. /Aided Junior College of their native or residing Mandal only.

Improvement Provision for Second Year Passed Candidates:

The candidates who passed two year Intermediate course can improve their performance within two years. They can avail only two chances during this period. The passed candidates of IPASE May/June 2019 can appear for Improvement in I.P.A.S.E 2021 as a last chance if they did not avail two chances in the previous I.P.Es. The candidates who wish to improve their performance have to appear for all the second year papers including Practicals (OR) to appear for all papers of first and second year including Practicals. The successful candidates have an option to retain the present performance or past performance whichever is beneficial to the candidates. There is no provision of Best marks in individual papers, like in first year.

REMITTANCE OF EXAMINATION FEE THROUGH ONLINE:

The Board of Intermediate Education has introduced the system to collect the Examination & other fee through State Bank of India, Machavaram Branch, Vijaywada and IDBI Bank, Ring Road Branch, Vijayawada through online transfer from the existing college Accounts to B.I.E Account of the concerned banks through e-challan generated by the http://bie.ap.gov.in in the web site for First and Second year candidates with effect from IPASE July 2020. The principals of the colleges, who do not have their accounts in the above two banks, are also informed to pay the fee through the generated challan provided in the BIE web site http://bie.ap.gov.in in any one of the two banks. The Account Numbers of two banks are furnished hereunder for online transfer of the examination fee.

Separate e-challan is to be used for each category i.e., General/Vocational, Improvement, Non-Improvement and Additions.

At the backside of each e-challan the Principals have to write the following information without fail.

1) College Code 2) College stamp 3) General/Vocational. 4) Improvement/Non-Improvement. 5) No. of candidates paid fee 6) Amount paid in words and figures.

It is informed that there will be no further extension of examination fee due dates. Therefore it is requested to give wide publicity to the above fee due dates among the students, and parents.
